#### Day of the Dead

November 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> mark the Mexican holiday of "Dia de los Muertos" or Day of the Dead. Also recognized throughout Latin America, Dia de los Muertos is not a Mexican version of Halloween, but is instead a celebration of loved ones who have passed away, and a way to show love and respect for them. One of the more beautiful traditions during Dia de los Muertos is "ofrendas" which refers to making put memorials on an altar to remember those who have passed away. We will be doing the same thing here at Coalbanks to remember those who have passed away.
