Health and Wellness

Head Lice can be a problem in any school! Lice are wingless insects that live on the head. They are greyish-brown in color and are very small and hard to find. Nits are tiny eggs laid by the female louse and are attached to the hair shaft close to the scalp. Lice are spread from human to human. Any family can get lice, they are not a sign of poor hygiene. Lice spread either by close head to head contact or indirectly by sharing hats, combs, scarves, pillow, bedding etc.
