 - Assurance Survey Results Report-Mr. Gentile will share the drafted results report and will ask for feedback from parents in attendance regarding our results. Results report will be shared at the meeting. Review complete.
 - Budget Update for the 2025-2026 School Year Budget is by far the worst budget. Major shortfalls at Coalbanks, staff will be reduced. Losing a teacher, support staff and office staff and caretaking staff will be cut. 1.5m to trim (Spanish teachers big part, 400k to complete) Contact MLA to inform them how important the teachers and support staff are and how they need more help. Cost of living and salaries are not where they need to be, the complex needs are the highest demand at this point. Will be a challenging year. Please support, lobby public education.
 - Modular Construction Update Not one modular project has ever started on time. Wards Bro. Game plan was to move the modulars over break when the kids were not here. August 15th was the promised occupancy date. As more information comes they will keep us posted.
 - Classlists introduction of a new program called Class Solver Classlists will not be ready until September. Grade 4/5 classes are higher 24/25 kids per class. Looking to split the kids up to add another teacher is the goal. Info will be sent the last weekend in August as usual. New program will be used – great program – Class Solver. Characteristics and rules to help sort the kids appropriately. Will be able to help out grade 5 students moving to grade 6.

 - District Council Report Skye Craig Good presentation about the REP program, 7,8 and plus. Positive feedback. Quick meeting. Talked about busing, budget, code of conduct. Next meeting June 9th and that will be food and meeting. Board report ICE scholarship total \$14,000 for sponsorships. Amazing entrepreneurship. Tim Horton's smile cookie campaign raised \$70,000. Cardiac Arrest response plan. 3 simple things: What to assume and what to do, this poster will be put up in schools. Information: Less that 10 staff that are trained in first aid. Would be awesome to have half the staff trained in first aid. How can we fix this? Can a PD day be set for first aid certification? 7 policies are ready to go out of 30.

Budget: Because of the govt. wanting us to use up the surplus. We are down to 1.5 % of our budget. No wiggle room. Facing a 6million defecate. Middle of September to run for school board. Our grade levels have not been reviewed in 21 years. Elementary being K-6, middle school being 7-9, and high school 10-12. Working hard to mitigate the devastation.
