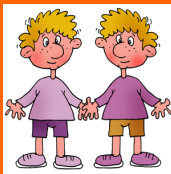
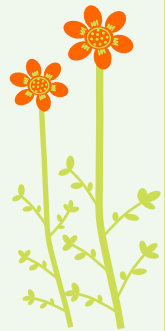


Coalbanks Talent Show

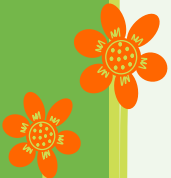

All supply lists can be found on our school website. Purchase supplies yourself or order your child(s) supplies from Staples or School Start.

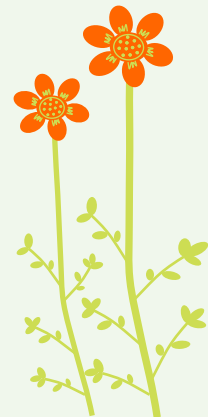

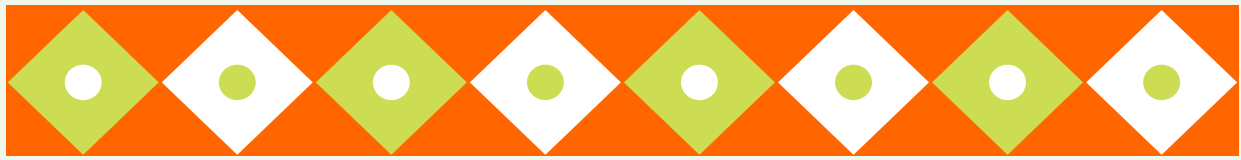
A message from the Learning Commons

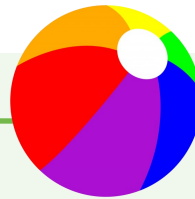
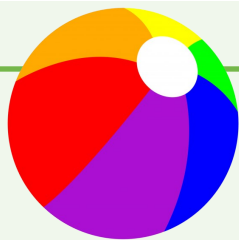
School Council Updates:
